HOW MUCH TIME DOES THIS REQUIRE?

Thanks to the University of Colorado Denver, we use ZOOM video conferencing for our Executive Committee Meetings (6/year) and for half of our Full Board Meetings (6/year). Meetings are typically less than 1.5 hours. **Full board physical meetings will only take place 3 times per year**, with one of those times being a full-day strategic planning session.

Committee participation is encouraged. Ours include: Executive, Programs and Finance, Board Membership, & Personnel. On average, you should expect no more than 6 hours max per month of a time commitment.

I DON'T HAVE MUCH BOARD EXPERIENCE. IS THAT OK?

It is definitely ok. With a relatively newer board, we are committed to board development and education to ensure everyone has the needed foundation to be successful.
