HOW MUCH TIME DOES THIS REQUIRE?

Thanks to the University of Colorado Denver, we use ZOOM video conferencing for our Executive Committee Meetings (6/year) and for half of our Full Board Meetings (6/year). **Meetings are typically less than 1.5 hours. Full board physical meetings will only take place 3 times per year**, with one of those times being a full-day strategic planning session.

Committee participation is encouraged. Ours include: Executive, Programs and Finance, Board Membership, & Personnel. On average, you should expect no more than 6 hours max per month of a time commitment.

Board terms are for 3 years.

BE HONEST, DO YOU JUST WANT MY MONEY?

Nope. We want directors with knowledge, skill, ideas, and passion for improving the future of healthcare. Yes, we ask for a personal financial contribution, but there is no fixed amount. We ARE a non-profit, but we'd rather have active board members who can help us identify new funding sources than nickel and dime our directors.
